LB 562, 1241

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 562. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 562 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 562. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. We will now turn to Item 14 on the agenda, motions to return from Final Reading. And the first bill we have is LB 1241.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator...well, first of all, Senator Withem had amendments. Senator, AM4085, it was given to me earlier, not today but April...

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator, I assume that applies to one you...it's an FA, Senator, you'd given me earlier.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Robinson. Senator, you had an amendment.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I'm going to withdraw my motion to return. It has to do with the renting of the buildings at the School for the Deaf and School of the Visually Impaired. I just wanted to make the statement that these will be handled by the State Department of Education. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Robinson. It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Peterson would move to return the bill. AM4104, Senator.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Peterson. Senator Withem.

SENATOR PETERSON: It's also Senator Withem, and I signed on to this.
