CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment I have, Senator Wickersham, I have a note that you want to withdraw AM3283. Is that correct, Senator?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators Beutler and Wickersham, AM3655. To be withdrawn, Senator? No, right?

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis would move to return the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Landis. It's passed over. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, where are we?

SPEAKER BAACK: Hall, you're in the Legislative Chamber.

SENATOR HALL: I know where I am, I just wondered where we were, collectively.

SPEAKER BAACK: (Laughter.) Senator Hall, we are on LB 1000, and all the amendments were withdrawn off that bill.

SENATOR HALL: So, is that bill read, or do we keep moving?

SPEAKER BAACK: That bill will be read now, because it has nothing filed on it. Yeah, we'll go to LB 126.

CLERK: Mr. President, 126, Senator Lynch would move to return the bill for specific amendment. (Lynch amendment may be found on page 1012 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. President, members, as quickly as I can I want to bring this...is an amendment that has to do with LB 126, and it relates directly to an amendment that was offered by Senator Hall on February 13, 1992, and it was adopted with very little discussion, which is fine. There was no public hearing, but it was the kind of thing that probably deserved a public hearing of some kind. It involves an off airport area parking
