SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Mr. Clerk, LB 719A.

CLERK: (Began reading LB 719A.)

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Continued reading LB 719A.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Could I have the senators please return to their seats and check in, please. Senators, please return to your seats and check in, please. Senators, please check in. Senator Schrock, would you check in, please. Senator Wesely, would you check in, please. Senator Lynch, would you check in, please. We are looking for Senators Landis and Lindsay. CLERK: (Read LB 754 on Final Reading.)
