As far as procedure is concerned, this was never a bill that was introduced. It was never...it never had a hearing because it was never a bill that was introduced. The thought and concept of it was added to another bill when it took its place on Select File. That same day that it was discussed on the floor it appeared in the Journal and that was the reason the people at the Airport Authority and I and many others really didn't understand the consequence of what was happening. It makes sense to me that we should consider this and not allow the bill to pass, consider it over the summer and by next year have a better understanding of what may or may not be possible. One of the arguments that was used was is that if people can use public roads to pick up people at the airport, they should not have to pay a fee. Just for the record, I would like to point out that all of the public roads around the airport were, in fact, built and paid for from the fee process utilized at the airport. They were then dedicated for public use to the city. There are many things like that we should know and understand. I would think we would want to do exactly everything we can to be fair not only to the Airport Authority and not jeopardize them in any way so they would have to levy a tax any time in the future but also be fair to those people that have parking facilities. And I would also like to suggest that we either...we just not vote on this legislation. Hopefully, it won't get enough to be successful and during the summer and before next year resolve this with some meaningful legislation with adequate processes being served, including a bill being introduced in the hearing process.
