We'll proceed with roll call vote on the motion to return to Select File.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Roll call vote taken. See page 2221 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 22 nays on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion fails.

ASSISTANT CLERK: In that case, Madam President, Senator Will would move to return the bill for a specific amendment, that being to strike the enacting clause.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: I would withdraw that motion.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Are there further motions?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Haberman, you had an amendment that I understood was to be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Haberman.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Withdraw? Madam President, Senator Withem would move to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Madam Chair and members of the body, I put a motion up there I wanted to speak on the previous motion. Did not get an opportunity to and the only reason is to put into the record what I hope will be a clarification of a point made in the earlier discussion.
