PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Will. Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Call the question.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Are there sufficient seconds? There are. We will now vote on the motion to cease debate. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to cease debate? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to cease debate.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Debate has ceased. I'll recognize Senator Will for closing.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Madam President. I think we all know what the issue is. It's 6:10, I don't want to waste a lot of time. This is simply this is the remote racing bill that we approved with 33 votes. I think we need to send a message. The message we need to send is very simple and that is if we pass the bill with 33 votes we mean it. I would encourage you to vote to override the veto. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Will. We will now vote on the motion to override. All of those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I ask that we all have a call of the house and roll call vote.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Will. We have a request for call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. The house is under call. Would the senators please check in. Senator Bernard-Stevens, please check in. Senator Lynch and Senator Robak, please check in. We are looking for Senator Lynch.
