SENATOR WILL: I don't know.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If it is, do you think it will be resolved in less than six months?

SENATOR WILL: I would certainly hope that it would be resolved as soon as possible.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do you think it will be resolved in less than eight months?

SENATOR WILL: I don't know that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Why is this money needed, since it is not likely under the best of scenarios that it is going to have to be spent because the bill is not going to be operational?

SENATOR WILL: Well, typically, Senator Chambers, what we do is we make a judgment as to what an agency tells us they will have to do in order to spend money to implement legislation. The Fiscal Office drafts an A bill, and this is what we have got right now.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If this bill did not pass, it wouldn't hurt at all what you have attempted to do so far, would it?

SENATOR WILL: The provisions of LB 718 would be in effect.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What are they going to spend the money for?

SENATOR WILL: I think they are going to spend the money for enforcement and oversight of any remote facilities that are put in place.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. I want to ask Senator Schellpeper a question.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Schellpeper, are you the one who specifically said the tracks have said they will immediately file, take this to court to see if it is constitutional?
