PRESIDENT MOUL: (Microphone not activated) ...ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain this morning is Senator Roger Wehrbein of the Second Legislative District. Senator Wehrbein.

In addition, Madam President, I have hearing notices from the Government Committee, Chaired by Senator Conway; from the Education Committee, Chaired by Senator Withem; and the Banking Committee, Chaired by Senator Landis, for confirmation hearings. I also have a hearing notice from the Revenue Committee, signed by Senator Hall, scheduling the various resolutions and bills introduced for public hearing on Wednesday, commencing at nine o'clock.
