SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: (Microphone not activated.) ...and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. And with us for the prayer this morning, for the chaplain of the day we have Senator Elroy Hefner. Senator Hefner.
