SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us this morning for the opening prayer we have Senator Carol Pirsch. Senator Pirsch.

SENATOR PIRSCH: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Pirsch. Roll call. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any items for the record?

CLERK: I have no items at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Okay, we will now proceed to Item 5, the confirmation report from the Health and Human Services Committee and my understanding is, Senator Dierks, you are going to handle that.

SENATOR DIERKS: Yes, Mr. Speaker, and members of the body, the Chairman and Vice-Chairman, I believe, of the Health and Human Services Committee are in Omaha this morning for that meeting and so I was asked to present this confirmation to the legislative body. The committee held confirmation hearings on Susan A. Thomas, Louise D. Schleich, both from the Child Abuse Prevention Board; for Jacklyn Smith, Director of the Department of Aging; for Myrna Schmid and Vicki Powell for the Foster Care Review Board. They were all approved unanimously by those who were present and I would ask for your approval on the floor this morning. And we suggest that a record vote be taken. Thank you.
