CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the confirmation report as offered by the Health and Human Services Committee.

SPEAKER BAACK: The report is adopted. We will now proceed to item 7 on the agenda and Select File and LB 2.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 2 is on Select File. I have no E & R amendments. I do have an amendment pending to the bill by Senator Warner as Chair of the Board. The amendment is found on page 86 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Moore, are you going to handle this amendment?

SENATOR MOORE: Yes. I will try and handle this amendment, Mr. Speaker. This amendment, it's printed in the Journal?

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, sir, page 86.

SENATOR MOORE: Okay. Page 86. And what this is is basically amends this bill to reflect the probability of an extended session. I optimistically say that, as is originally planned. You remember, originally, we had appropriated \$26,800, well, more than that, actually, but we raised the dollar amount to reflect the extension of three days of the session. And if that does not happen, obviously, we will not expend the money. If it does happen, we will have appropriated the money and have that money in the Legislative Council's budgets so we can reimburse all affected parties for the special session. So, with that, I would ask for adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Moore. Is there discussion on the amendment as offered by Senator Moore? Seeing none, Senator Moore, do you wish to close? He waives closing. We will now vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Moore's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?
