CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Landis's first amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. We will now go to the second half. We are dealing with the second half of Landis's...Senator Landis's amendment. List of speakers, Senator Schimek, did you wish to address that? Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I would like to yield my time to Senator Hall.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. Speaker, I would move we recess until one-thirty.

SPEAKER BAACK: We have a motion to recess until one-thirty. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a Natural Resources Committee report, signed by Senator Johnson as Chair of the committee regarding certain gubernatorial appointees and confirmation hearing.

LBs 2 and 3 are reported correctly engrossed; and I have a corrected appointment letter from the Governor's Office, as well as a second appointment to the Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice. That is all that I have, Mr. President.

SENATOR LANDIS: Board vote.

SPEAKER BAACK: Okay, we do have a motion to recess until one-thirty and a board vote has been requested. All those in...we will now vote on recessing until one-thirty. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the motion to recess. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 18 nays to recess, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion fails. We will now continue with discussion on the amendment offered by Senator Landis, and the next...Senator Schimek, you did not wish to address this, correct? Okay, Senator Hall, your light is on next.
