PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain this morning is Senator Scott Moore of the 24th Legislative District. Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. I now call to order the Eighth Day of the Ninety-Second Legislature, First Special Session. We will proceed with roll call. Please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: I would like to direct the senators' attention now to the area under the north balcony. Special guests of the Legislature today are my sister, Chris Johnson, of Oakland and her sister-in-law, Robin Johnson, of Oakland. Would you please stand and be recognized. They are constituents of Senator Robinson. Are there any messages, reports or announcements, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Madam President, LR 1CA is reported to Select File with Enrollment and Review amendments attached. And that's all that I have this morning.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will proceed with Item 5 on the agenda, LR 10.

CLERK: Madam President, LR 10 was introduced by Senator Wehrbein and a number of the members. It's found on page 99 of the Legislative Journal. It asks that the Legislature support Cargill, Inc's plans for building a corn wet milling plant near Nebraska City in Otoe County.
