SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. The next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further pending to LB 6 at this time.

SPEAKER BAACK: We are now on the motion to advance LB 6. Anyone wish to discuss the advancement of LB 6? Seeing no one, Senator Hall, do you wish to close on the advancement of LB 6?

SENATOR HALL: Only to move advancement to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing. We will now vote on the advancement of LB 6. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 6. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, and a record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 119 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 12 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 6 advances. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. Speaker, I would like to request that that bill be expedited.

SPEAKER BAACK: It has been. Items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a confirmation hearing notice by the Government Committee, signed by Senator Conway as Chair of the committee. LR 10 is ready for your signature, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 10. We will now proceed to Item 9, Select File, on LR 1.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first item for consideration is the consideration of Enrollment and Review amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LR 1.
