

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Conway. Madam President, members of the body, Senator Conway did ask my question...answer my question, I mean. But I would rise to support the Conway amendment and indicate my belief that this again illustrates one of the many problems that we're going to run into with inventories all across the State of Nebraska. This is, as Senator Conway explained, certainly a unique situation because of the registration of vehicles. But it is an omen of things to come, if we continue on what some would have to be the present course. Thank you, Madam President. Thank you, Senator Conway.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. You've heard closing. We'll now vote on the Conway amendment to LB 6. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Conway's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Elmer would move to amend. (Elmer amendment appears on page 125 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Elmer.

SENATOR ELMER: Thank you, Madam President. The amendment that I'm proposing to you has been passed out to you, it's AM070 "Sierra", 70S. It does two things. One, it guarantees us that if such a thing might happen, as LB 6 would pass and become law and not be accompanied by the constitutional amendment, then the provisions of LB 6 would become mainly void. The second thing it does is very substantive. It strikes the sunset on the exemptions of December 31, 1991. So what we would have, if the constitutional amendment were passed, or if it was not to the polls September 17th, we would have LB...which one is it, 829 that guides us through to the first of January. Then the first of January all tangible, personal property would become exempt and we would go from there. I can't support the constitutional amendment with the 30 votes with the way that LB 6 is now structured. If we can get LB 6 to this structure, where we start with all personal property exempt, the liars tax no longer is there. The thing that has caused us all our problems is no longer there. Takes 30 votes to get the exemptions back off
