SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, Senator Elmer, no chance, this is not going to go. I don't even know if it's constitutional to say that if an act does not occur then a provision of law is not effective. We either pass a law or we don't. We can delay the date when it takes effect, but we cannot make it contingent upon some other happening before the law is effective. So I think it will give you an opportunity to say what you want you want to say. But I don't think it would be voted upon by a majority of the body. So maybe you could save yourself some grief and just withdraw it.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Does anyone else wish to address this amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Elmer?

SENATOR ELMER: Senator Chambers, we have some other areas in this same LB 6 that are contingent on whether or not the constitutional amendment passes or it does not. I think this is no different. I think this is no different. It just is 180 degrees of what we have now. I think people aren't too interested in this proposal, I can see right now. But I think it's fair. I think it's a fair one to run. So let's see how bad it goes here. (Laugh.) And I'd ask for your help in adopting this amendment.
