

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I would like to withdraw that amendment.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Hall would move to amend. Senator, AM051S. (Hall amendment appears on pages 126-27 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President, members. Again, this is a technical amendment. There was a provision in the bill where November 12th was omitted from the Section 2, and what we do is add that and state also in that Section 13-509 with regard to the county assessors that the language that is throughout the bill that if constitutional amendment, Article VIII of the Constitution is adopted, what duties are required to be performed on or before November 12th shall be formed on or before November...or on or before September 27th. So we had to add that language in this section, as it is in every other section. All we did was leave 13-509 out of the bill. Bill Drafter's caught it. It is a technical change, does not change the bill in any significant way. I would urge adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. Is there anyone who wishes to address the Hall amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the Hall amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Hall's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the bill, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.
