

will go ahead and vote on LR 1. If the support is there, we will have a pretty good indication. If not, we will see what the next motion is, and at this time, I guess I would ask to withdraw the bracket motion.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is withdrawn. We have nothing else on the desk. Would the senators please return to their seats so we can proceed with Final Reading. Okay, we will proceed with Final Reading on LR 1.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LR 1 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LR 1 pass? A roll call vote has been requested.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 147 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 29 ayes, 15 nays, 1 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The resolution does not pass.

ASSISTANT CLERK: In that case, Madam President, Senator Kristensen would move to adjourn sine die.

PRESIDENT MOUL: A machine vote has been requested and a roll call vote has been requested. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 147-48 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 21 ayes, 22 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion to adjourn fails.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Madam President, I have a motion from Senator Hall. Senator Hall would move to return the resolution to Select File for a specific amendment. (The Hall amendment appears on pages 148-50 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President, and members. The proposal did not, in its current form, have the votes. What I've put up is a different amendment that does exactly the same thing than I offered earlier. So if you would refer to your
