

Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 18 nays on the motion to return the resolution.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion is successful. We will now go to the amendment by Senator Hall.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Hall would move to adjourn sine die.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall and body, if there is no objection, could we handle the confirmation report from the Government Committee before we vote on this? We do have a confirmation report that has been submitted to the body and I would like to deal with that if we could before we adjourn. Is there any objection? Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, Senator Conway would move to report favorably on the appointment of Jean Lovell as Executive Director of the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, and members, the Government Committee, upon review of the credentials of Jean Lovell who has been nominated by the Governor for that position and having a confirmation hearing, did vote in a seven or unanimous support vote for with one member absent and not able to vote to advance to this body the acceptance of that nomination for her to serve as Executive Director of the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice. I would offer that to the body for an affirmative or, hopefully, an affirmative vote on the part of the body to confirm her for that position.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any discussion of the confirmation report as offered by Senator Conway? Seeing none, we will proceed to vote on the confirmation report. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
