

with Item 5 on the agenda. Speaker Baack, do you wish to be recognized?

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes. Madam President, colleagues, just so I might make a brief announcement about how we're going to proceed as far as the agenda goes. We will be taking up LB 2 in a little while, and then after LB 2 we will be taking up LB 1, and then we will take up LB 3, because LB 3 is out, too, right now. I know that the committee's plan with these bills, the committee put out two bills, the Revenue Committee did. Senator Hall relayed this information to me, they put out two bills, hoping that they would be able to keep LB 1 as a fairly clean, cleanup kind of bill for the LB 1063. And then LB 3 is out there so that you could use that bill as a vehicle for amendments that you might want to make to LB 1063. This is the hope of the committee, that's why they put two bills out there. LB 1 came out fairly clean. So we'll discuss that one first, then we will go to LB 3, after that. I've had a lot of people ask me are we going to work straight through today, are we going to recess for lunch. I don't know yet. We're going to kind of gauge it by how the debate goes and how we sit time wise. And if I see we can get done fairly early in the afternoon we may work straight through, or we may recess for lunch. I'll make that determination a little later on. If we do move these bills off of General File, my guess is we will be back on Select File on Friday on these bills. Then we will have to see what we...what the Government Committee does with the redistricting bills. If those bills come out today or a bill comes out of there we will start the General File debate on that bill tomorrow. So we'll...that's how we're going to proceed. If I have any other information to update later on, I will do that. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Speaker Baack. We'll now proceed then with LB 2. Senator Warner.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 2 was a bill introduced by Senators Warner and Baack. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on July 31st of this year, referred directly to General File, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, as indicated by the Clerk, LB 2 is the appropriation necessary for the Special Session. I would indicate that, as you see the
