SENATOR ROBINSON: I know it.

SENATOR CONWAY: ...Republicans or Democrats and using that as a basis.

SENATOR ROBINSON: You probably know what I'm referring to. Well, you know, you could go out and get so many people to run and, you know, you think this guy could get four or five hundred votes and take them away from some candidate. That's a possibility in this, would be a possibility in this type of race. Am I right or wrong?

SENATOR CONWAY: That is always subject to...that possibility is possible, yes.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Okay, thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Robinson. Senator Schimek. Anyone else wishing to discuss the bill? If not, Senator Conway, do you wish to close?

SENATOR CONWAY: Given the time that we've spent discussing the amendment which is now in essence the bill, I simply move the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing on the advancement of LB 7. We will now vote on the advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 7. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk. Record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 91-92 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, Senator Schmit voting yes, 26 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 7.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 7 advances. We will now proceed to LB 15.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 15 was a bill originally introduced by Senators Schrock and Elmer. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on July 31 of this year, referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill at this time.
