

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Haberman, that is not my prerogative to rule whether it's within the call or without the call. I think that what you can do is to make that argument to the body that it is not within the call and argue against advancement of the bill on that basis. But it is not within the duty of the Chair to make that kind of call as to whether or not this is within or without the call.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. Speaker, in the past and due to my recollection might be a little fuzzy, but I think that the Speaker has declared something is within or not within the call.

SPEAKER BAACK: I have no documentation of that but in this case, Senator Haberman, I think you can make that argument to the body that it's not in the call and then the body will make their own judgment as to whether or not it is within the call. I think that should be a call for the whole Legislature to make, not just for the presiding officer; so I will not make a ruling on that. We do have a motion from Senator Haberman.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Haberman would move to indefinitely postpone LB 15. Senator Schrock would have the option to lay the bill over.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schrock said to take it up. Senator Haberman, on your motion to indefinitely postpone.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President and members of the body, what is being proposed in LB 15 is they're trying to make a county whole, but in making the county whole, they are fracturing two other counties. So as it is now under LB 814 (sic), only one county is fractured. But under LB 15, two counties are fractured so we're doubling the problem. It cuts part of Furnas County out of 38th District and puts it in the 44th District. And it cuts out parts of Nuckolls County of the 32nd District and places it in the 38th District. The senator representing the 38th District will not reside in the district. There will be two senators in the 44th District. So for starters, those are the reasons I would like to suggest to this body that we do not have and we do not advance and we do indefinitely postpone LB 15.
