CLERK: Madam President, the first report is offered by the Health and Human Services Committee, chaired by Senator Wesely. The report is found on page 87 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Madam President, members. On behalf of the Health and Human Services Committee, I do offer to you the recommendation to approve the appointments of Dr. Mark Kellough to the State Board of Health. Dr. Kellough is a chiropractor from Lincoln. Violet Fickel, an appointee to the Foster Care Review Board. Violet is from Omaha. Julie Dahlke, an appointee to the Commission for the Hearing Impaired; she's from Lincoln. And Lindsay Darnall, who is an appointee to the Commission for the Hearing Impaired, who is from Polk. We had a hearing. These individuals appeared before us, and the committee did approve unanimously the confirmation of these appointees, and move for their adoption by the Legislature.
