And the second appointment is Mr. Gary Goldberg, who is a farmer from the Kearney area. Mr. Goldberg is being nominated to the Ethanol Authority and Development Board. The Natural Resources Committee met recently to review these nominations and did unanimously approve them, and I would move the adoption by the body. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Horgan. Does anyone wish to speak to these confirmation reports? Seeing none, we will now vote on the confirmation reports from the Natural Resources Committee. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the confirmation report? Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Horgan.

SENATOR HORGAN: A lack of three votes, I guess we may have to ask for a call of the house and accept call-in votes, please.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 9 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. All members, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. The house is under call. Would Senators Lamb, Lynch, Byars, and Peterson please check in, please. Senator Coordsen, Senator Robinson, Senator Rogers, Senator Elmer, Senator Haberman, please check in. Senator Schellpeper, Senator Schrock. Senator Hefner, Senator Hillman, Senator Wesely, please check in, and Senator Labeledz. Senator Horgan, are call-in votes accepted? We will accept call-in votes on the confirmation report.

CLERK: Senator Labeledz voting yes. Senator Morrissey voting yes. Senator Baack voting yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the confirmation report, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The confirmation report is adopted. I will raise the call.
