CLERK: The next report is offered by the Government Committee. It's found on page 86 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam Chairman. The Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee held a confirmation hearing two days, three days ago, I guess, now, and to deal with an accountability and disclosure position that was open, and the nominee was a Mr. Bob Shively. Following that hearing, the committee voted to advance Mr. Shively's name to this body for confirmation on a unanimous vote. And I recommend that the body support that nominee for the position on the Accountability and Disclosure Commission.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Madam President. . Madam President, I'd like to ask Senator Conway, to yield to a question.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR WESELY: My question, Senator Conway, is I...as we've discussed a bit here before this came up, I had read something about the possibility of this individual or somebody with a similar name being involved in a campaign, currently ongoing right now. If anybody is appointed to the Accountability and Disclosure Commission and is involved in a legislative or other type of campaign, ballot issue, whatever, they must stop that activity once a member of Accountability and Disclosure? I mean anybody on that commission is devoid of any direct ties to any candidate or campaign activity, isn't that correct?

SENATOR CONWAY: It is my understanding that any of the commission members, upon being on that commission, that they are from that point on barred from any activity, whether it be a ballot issue, or a candidate on one side or the other, or any political party involvement from that point on while they're serving as commission.

SENATOR WESELY: Okay, thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Senator Moore. Okay. Any further questions on this confirmation report? Seeing none, we will now vote on the Government Committee's
