

district. That's the least disruptive. When us senators met up in northeast Nebraska we decided what can we do that would be the least disruptive to anybody. You're going to affect two people no matter what you do. It's going to be the people in Madison County that are on the ballot this fall and it's going to be the two people in District 19 at the present time. But when you have a court case that has already told you that Madison County will be a district, I think that has to take precedence over anything else at this time. So whether we move on or whether we do nothing, right now I think that court case is number one for this body and we need to make sure that we do something in this special session. Thank you.
