

SENATOR SCHROCK: (Microphone not activated)...help matters any.

SPEAKER BAACK: Call-in votes have been authorized.

CLERK: Senator Labeledz voting yes.

SPEAKER BAACK: We are voting on the advancement of LB 15 and call-in votes have been authorized.

CLERK: Senator Wehrbein voting yes. Senator Crosby voting yes. Senator Lowell Johnson voting no. Senator Robinson voting yes. Senator Bernard-Stevens voting no.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Lowell Johnson, would you check in, please. Senator Robinson, would you check in, please. Senator Lynch. Senator Wesely. We're looking for Senator Wesely. Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: (Microphone not activated)...vote.

SPEAKER BAACK: Roll call vote has been requested. Reverse order has been requested. We are waiting...we are waiting for Senator Wesely. Senator Schrock has said we may proceed with the roll call vote. The roll call vote has been requested in reverse order. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.
