SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Good morning, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us for the prayer this morning is Senator Dierks, from District Number 40. Senator Dierks.

SENATOR DIERKS: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Dierks. I now call to order the sixth day of the Ninety-Second Legislature, Second Special Session. Roll call. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.
