SENATOR HARTNETT: I want to apologize for the senator from Indianola that I didn't know he was a registered pilot. So, with that, I would ask people to adopt the resolution.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing on LR 5. We'll now vote on LR 5. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 5.

SPEAKER BAACK: LR 5 is adopted. We'll now go to LR 6.

CLERK: LR 6, introduced by Senator Robinson. (Read brief summary of resolution.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: I'll keep...Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I'll keep this brief. It's very difficult for me to do things like that in instances such as this. But let me read the resolution to you, then I'll have a couple of comments. Whereas the Midget and Legion baseball teams from Blair both won their respective Class B State Championships this past weekend; Whereas these victories represent the fifth championship for each team, and this is the second time they have been...both been champions in the same year; and Whereas Dan Petersen is the head coach and Pete Svengard is the assistant coach of the Blair Midget team; and Whereas Mark Gutschow is the head coach and Scott Nicholson is the assistant coach of the Blair Legion team; Mr. Gutschow has been involved in every championship the Legion team has won and deserves special recognition for this accomplishment; Whereas the hard work and dedication of players and coaches on both teams is an inspiration to the Blair community and deserves recognition by the Legislature. Now, therefore, be it resolved by the members of the Ninety-Second Legislature of Nebraska, that the Legislature recognizes and congratulates the Blair Midget and Legion baseball teams on their recent championships. I approached the Speaker on this, and he said, well, did they beat any teams from his district? And I said, well, I know they didn't beat Kimball or Sidney. He said, about Ogallala, he said, how about Ogallala? I said, they upset Ogallala! He said, fine, I'll let this resolution go through.
