PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 1 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 2.

CLERK: (Read LB 2 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 2 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 142 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 2 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 3.

CLERK: Madam President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Withem would move to return LB 3 to Select File for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, Madam Chair, members of the body, my amendment is not printed, is not distributed, but it's very simple. It simply strikes the Lamb amendment that was adopted on Select File, as I understand it, that amendment, which exempts all livestock from property taxation. I know a lot of people want to leave. I know a lot of people aren't very excited about being here in special session and then the goal is to get out of here today.
