SENATOR PETERSON: I'd ask for a roll call vote in regular order.

SPEAKER BAACK: A roll call vote has been requested. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 147-48 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 7 does not pass with the emergency clause. We have a motion on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bernard-Stevens would move to reconsider the vote on Final Reading on LB 7E with the emergency clause attached.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Bernard-Stevens. He withdraws the motion. The question now is, shall LB 7 pass without the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 148 of the Legislative Journal.) 13 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President, on the passage.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 7 fails. We will now proceed to LB 9.

CLERK: (Read LB 9 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 9 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 149 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 9 does not pass with the emergency clause. Members, would you please take your seats, please. We are on Final Reading. The question now is, shall LB 9 pass without the emergency clause? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
