PRESIDENT MOUL: Motion to reconsider is adopted. The motion now before the body is, shall LB 7 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 154 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 12 nays, 3 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 7 passes with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Clerk, further motions on the desk.
