PRESIDENT MOUL: Would the senators please check in. Senator Conway, Senator Coordsen, would you please check in. Senator Schrock, Senator Wesely, please check in. Senator Bernard-Stevens, please check in. Senator Conway, please check in. Senator Landis, Senator Wesely, please return to the Chamber and please check in. We are accepting call-in votes on the motion to cease debate.

CLERK: Senator Landis voting yes.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays to cease debate, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Debate has ceased. Will recognize Senator Chizek for closing.

SENATOR CHIZEK: Very briefly, Madam President. You heard Senator Chambers and others eloquently present their views on Mr. Renteria. Undoubtedly, the Governor's Office felt that his experience, his work experience in and out of the corrections institution provided that background that was necessary. If you look at the difference statutorily between what they say for the Chairman of the Parole Board versus Corrections, you will see it is specifically spelled out. Now we may need to change the statute. I don't know. I won't be here. That will be a question that you, as a group, will have to address. The question is the Governor of this state feels that the man meets the statutory qualifications, made the recommendation, the committee voted 6 to 1 to advance it. It is now in your hands and I ask that you support the Governor's appointment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Chizek. Senator Chizek, we are only waiting for Senator Wesely. Do you want to proceed with the vote? We will now vote on the motion to adopt the confirmation report. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the confirmation report? Senator Chizek.

SENATOR CHIZEK: Well, it looks...let's have a roll call vote and get it over with.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Chizek. Proceed with the roll call vote.
