CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 158-59 of the Legislative Journal.) 18 ayes, 14 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The confirmation report is not adopted. Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk? Mr. Clerk, we have confirmation reports. I will raise the call.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Schellpeper, as Chair of General Affairs, has a confirmation report by the General Affairs Committee. Senator, the appointment to the Liquor Control Commission.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Schellpeper.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yes, thank you, Madam Chairman. We have the appointment of Jack Crowley from Hastings for the Nebraska Liquor Commission. He takes the place of Don Dworak. He is a Hastings businessman. I think he is very well qualified for the position and I would just move for his appointment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. Does anyone wish to speak to this appointment? Seeing none, we will now vote on the confirmation report. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted. Please record, Mr. Clerk.
