tomorrow. And so the suspension of this rule would allow that committee hearing to occur. You could argue...you would know a ball park estimate from the Fiscal Office what the dollar was, the amount. You would have the official fiscal note completed in time for the hearing. If you do not suspend this rule, then some of those hearings will not be able to be held until later in the week and it's...this way we could have the hearing and the fiscal note could come...could follow shortly thereafter. And so that's the intent behind the...behind the bill...this rule suspension. There is 19 bills already being read in there, and if all those hearings were tomorrow, it would be very difficult, if not impossible, to have all of those fiscal notes completed by tomorrow. And so that's the intent, that's why I'm making the motion for the rule suspension and we will do our very...the Fiscal Office will do their very best. If they're not done by the hearing, they will be done as close to the hearing date as possible. But even by the hearing you will know a tentative number as to the dollar impact, though not an official fiscal note.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to suspend the rules by Senator Moore. Is there any discussion of that motion? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Moore?

SENATOR MOORE: Simply move for the adoption of the rule suspension.
