SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Welcome to the Legislative Chamber. For the opening prayer today we have Harland Johnson.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Harland. I now call to order the fifth day of the Ninety-Second Legislature, Second...or Third Special Session. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.
