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I can, without divulging too much, show you how the system is abused. This is a family of six, four children. He was out of the home for a couple years, as far as I know. She has been on welfare at least from October of '89. Self-employed, has very, very ambitious, very intelligent, nice looking lady. So she was the primary supporter of the family while he was out of the home. Back again, both of them are certified, I guess I can say it, certified floral decorators, took some honors in a four state convention. They do a lot of...it's a business that they...self-employed. She sings at a lot of weddings and funerals, again. And this was drawn to my attention, people wondered how they could be on welfare. I did, too. This was an eye-opener to me. A family of six, there are some that are smart enough to stay within the system and the system allows it. I did a lot of homework on this. I'm telling you the file was two or two and a half inches thick that the social service worker did. I don't know how many of you know but a family of six can have an income up to \$2,507 a month and still qualify for full Medicaid, and that maxes down to \$1,826. Food stamps \$1,942 a month, Senator Chambers, and still get food stamps. This family received \$339 worth of food stamps in the month of June, 127 in July, and the income that I am able to trace and social security is just right on \$2,000 a month, and they're on full Medicaid. She sees a chiropractor doctor once a week, of which we're paying for. She's gone 27 or 28 treatments. She goes to an orthopedic surgeon for heel spurs and we're paying for that. But she is able to go to the Diet Center, \$44 a week, on her own. She has another income of \$140 a month that I'm able to trace, besides the self-employment income. He refused to work more than 32 to 38 hours a week, because he was helping her. That's fine. He has quit his job and is going to school now, I think, up in a north state. But what I'm saying is the system is absolutely wrong. We have elderly people, we have people that need assistance, need help, cannot get medication, and they live under the guidelines. I did not know that they could have income of this size. This family that I'm talking about, they are on full Medicaid. It was appealed from July 1 through September 30th. They are on unlimited Medicaid money, and that's not right, folks. The system allows this, and the system is wrong. We have elderly people, we have people that need help and they simply can't get it. I could go more into detail, but I'm trying to keep this as confidential as I can. It's just the fact that this is what is allowed and this is the reason that our Medicaid, one of the reasons that it's...no control on it whatsoever. You can up to \$1,642 a month and get
