CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report offered by the Education Committee.

SPEAKER BAACK: The confirmation report carries. We will now go to the second confirmation report by the Transportation Committee and Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature. This morning we have a position for Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board, and we bring to the floor of the Legislature the name of Marlin O. Armbruster, from Falls City, Nebraska. He's affiliated with Armbruster Motors in Falls City. He has served on this board prior. He answered our questions fully, and we believe that he would make an excellent candidate for this position, and we would recommend his confirmation by the Legislature. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Any other discussion on the confirmation report by the Transportation Committee? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Kristensen? Waives closing. We will now vote on the confirmation report. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
