SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR WESELY: ... (inaudible) into that last trimester we do lose something like over a million dollars in federal monies as a result of that. So that's one thing to keep in mind. But again, I'm unfortunately not in a position to support this amendment. And I do hope that at some point this is the policy position we end up with, it's the one I feel most comfortable with, but unfortunately am unable to assist Senator Chambers at this point.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Senator Chambers, you're next.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, a fellow named Sylvester Stalone made a movie called "Rocky" or "Rambo" and in one of them he says, looking very, very serious and whispers, which I'm not going to do because it was embarrassing for me to even listen to him do it, but his words were, I am or this is your worst nightmare. I am your conscience, that's all. I'm just holding a mirror up to your back to you what you've put out here, and I don't mind things that I've said and done being thrown back upon me. We are responsible for what we do and say. Now Senator Nelson has never been sympathetic to poor women. Somebody in her district always gives her a thick sheaf of papers where they find some person not doing right, and then she runs out all these things that people are getting, and if they're getting all that she says they're getting, and it's such a good life, she ought to get off of her farm and go ahead and get this aid herself. So whenever people itemize all this stuff it sounds good. But you know who can talk better about deficiency payments, target prices, subsidy, yeah right, she's putting up her hand, she can. Now she knows that system and she gets those freebies. Oh she said, no, no. She said, no, no, no, but her friends do, and I've never heard her speak against her friends getting those freebies. Senator Nelson, I don't get any of the benefits under the program we're talking about here, and there's no way that I can, unless there is some change that will occur in the biological universe that haven't at this point.
