And if you look at the facts about poverty, if you get this from Department of Social Services, it does tell you some of the things that Social Services works. As I said earlier, that these people on ADC are required to apply for jobs and try to get jobs regularly and that DSS follows up to be sure they are doing that and try to help them get those jobs. So I will ask you to vote for this amendment, and I'm going to vote for it and I would feel inconsistent if I did not try to help these young people, help them survive because I just feel very strongly that those who are poor in spirit do need our help. And I cannot turn my back on them. I cannot turn my back on the least of these. Thank you. I'd like a call of the house and a roll call vote in regular order. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.
