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absolutely no programs at Wayne State College, what happens to the entity of Wayne State College? Do they have the power to wipe out that entity of Wayne State College or not? And that's...we've talked about that a time or two and I think what is attempted to be discussed here is to make a determination of what happens if the review eliminates all the programs, what happens to the institution. And it may be too esoteric a discussion to be having and I don't know. I think what we've come up with is a general understanding that if...they have the power to eliminate the programs, so they choose to eliminate the programs, there is not an institution there. I think I have a colleague here indicating, obviously, we're not going to continue to fund it at one and a half million dollars if they aren't offering any classes there. So I don't know if the...the discussion, I think, has been a valuable one but I don't know if we need to take that additional step toward clarification at this point. It's your time, I guess. I apologize. My light's on. If you need more time, you can have mine.

SENATOR WESELY: Senator Elmer, would you agree with that analysis by Senator Withem?

SENATOR ELMER: I would think that, given the situation that we have, that the Postsecondary Education Commission would, if they intended to completely end any program, whether it's Curtis or Wayne State College, which is a possibility reaching infinite zero, that they're not going to actually dispose of the facility without making a recommendation to the Legislature and asking us to act on it, no matter what institution they might be looking at that they might want to completely stop. And I would assume that would be true for any institution, Curtis or otherwise, and that if they decide that they wish to do this with Curtis, they can eliminate the programs and come to us with a recommendation, but we would have very little choice but to follow it.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you. Senator Withem, your light is on.

SENATOR WITHEM: Never mind.
