

positions, numbers, and redistricting, representation, numbers of people on the board, and so on. So, with that, I believe that Senator Conway's resolution is accurate at this point in time. I also appreciated the opportunity to explain to people that we were not trying to eliminate the Public Service Commission, that we were merely trying to give us the flexibility, because at some time in the future I think that constitutional provision will be a major impediment to this Legislature doing what we need to do in terms of policy with that. In closing, I would support the amendment and the resolution. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Anyone wishing to discuss the amendment by Senator Conway? Senator Conway, do you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR CONWAY: I'll waive closing on the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now vote on the amendment by Senator Conway. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. The amendment does require 25 votes. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Conway's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted. We'll now go to discussion of the resolution as amended. Senator Moore, did you wish to discuss the resolution?

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, Mr. Speaker and members. LR 3, I think we need to think just a little bit before we advance it. And I have no problem with advancing it. But there is a concern I have. You all remember last year this body passed and enacted into law LB 988 which revamped our performance audit function of the Legislature, which used to be in the Appropriations Committee. It was the old sunset review statutes. And we finally reenacted that last year, which I think was a good move. And as you'll remember, in 988 we created a committee which, I believe, the last time the Exec Board met, prior to the session, we appointed some members to. If my memory serves me correctly, right now we are advertising for some individuals for support staff for that. And so that process is up and going. One of the concerns I have with LR 3 is there is a criteria set out in LB 988 and that new performance review statute for the senator and the Governor to submit ideas, for a senator and the Governor
