PRESIDENT MOUL: (Microphone not activated)...attention to the area in the south balcony. Special guests today of Senator LaVon Crosby are seven Tiger Club den members from Humann School in Lincoln, and they are accompanied by their parents. Would you please rise and be recognized. Welcome to the Chamber this morning. Thank you. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, your Committee on Revenue, whose Chairperson is Senator Hall, to whom was referred LB 1, instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File with committee amendments attached; LB 5 to General File. (See pages 24-25 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Mr. Speaker, would you like to address the Legislature on your intent with these bills.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, madam president, and colleagues, what we will do this morning is we will now take up the committee amendments on LB 1, and after we get the committee amendments to LB 1 adopted, then we will adjourn for the day, and we will not take up the regular General File debate until Monday. Thank you.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 1 was a bill originally introduced by Senators Warner, Baack, Hall and Landis at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on November 5 of this year, referred to the Revenue Committee. The bill advanced to General File this morning. I do have committee amendments pending by the Revenue Committee.
