other program is 123 which is the Clerk's office. A portion of this is the additional personnel such as Sergeant at Arms, Assistant Bill Room, Pages, total cost of \$7,500. And then the printing and the major cost would be the printing, the data processing, hookup of some of the phones within the Chamber and those kinds of costs, total of \$21,204, or net...or total increase for Program 123 of 28,700. That's what the bill is composed of and I move the bill be advanced, and again would indicate that it is based on a nine-day session and should we run a shorter period of time it can be reduced.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Does anyone wish to speak to this bill? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Warner? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the motion to advance LB 2. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have nothing at this time, Madam President.
