SENATOR SCHMIT: If, in fact, LB 6 were to be considered and passed by this Legislature, I might consider voting for LB 1. But without somehow seriously addressing the spending part of the equation, I cannot vote for LB 1. I know that we have serious problems and, Senator Hall, for those of us in agriculture, ought to be remembered as one who tried valiantly to work with us in the past session. He had been delivered a certain bag of groceries and he's got to try to make that thing work and to make that bag of groceries cover the kitchen table. And it's pretty difficult. And so, as of now, some of you who were not listening to him a year ago are finding yourself in an argumentative position with him now. Ladies and gentlemen,...

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.

SENATOR SCHMIT: ...it is too late for that now. But as of now I will not support amendment 1...LB 1.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Schmit. Anyone else wishing to address LB 1? Seeing no one, Senator Warner, do you wish to close?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, again the bill has been discussed substantially and I will not take the time, in view of the clock, to go reiterate its provisions. A suggestion has been made by a number that there are concerns that people would like to address and give some thought to for Select File and, obviously, those suggestions are in order and I assume will continue to be given thought and consideration to by all of us. But I do think it would be appropriate to move the bill now then and proceed with other alternatives that might be before us for those discussions. With that, Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced and ask for a call of the house prior to the vote.
