from that other than that benefit that Senator Warner so eloquently addressed, that benefit being staving off bringing into the local valuation all inventories, all income-producing equipment, and all the things that are necessary to provide the economic base for the State of Nebraska. That's the reason. We've move beyond that. That can no longer be the reason to continue a patently unfair tax. You recall several times on the floor of the Legislature I tried to explain how 1063 would work based upon the method that was used for valuing business equipment under the existing property tax laws. Apparently fell on deaf ears and we chose instead to impact production agriculture far more negatively by the use of the depreciation method than what was the fact...

Way worse than under the old book value system where a value for all farm equipment, a value for all livestock based upon age and those sorts of things was determined by the Department of Revenue and sent out to the assessors to use.
