CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have ceased debate and I will recognize Senator Warner for closing.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, in keeping with those who by their vote have indicated that it is the appropriate time to move the bill, again I will repeat what I said after lunch, that, obviously, there are some alternatives that people wish to explore. Select File seems the proper place. I would hope the body would advance the bill at this point so that we can continue to address the issue to partially, at least, fill the gap that exists in the revenue and the expenditure side, and lessen the problems for the next session. With that, Madam President, I would ask for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT MOUL: We have a request for call of the house. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The house is under call. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record their presence. All unauthorized personnel must leave the floor. Would the senators please check in. Senators Ashford, Chambers, Nelson, and Pirsch, please check in, and Senator Horgan. We are looking for Senators Ashford and Chambers. Senator Chambers, would you like to check in, please. Senator Warner, we are still waiting for Senator Ashford. He should be on his way back. Do you wish to proceed? We will wait. We will proceed now with the vote on the motion to advance LB 1. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk. A record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 32-33 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 17 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Madam President.
