SENATOR CONWAY: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is a reduction in the expense for the operation of the Legislature. You'll recall that it was introduced under the assumption that...at a funding level of nine legislative days, the assumption that we can complete the work in seven legislative days, the minimum required by the Constitution. This is a reduction in the total appropriation for the two programs, approximately \$14,000. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CONWAY: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, there are no lights. All in favor of the adoption of the amendment signify by voting aye, opposed nay. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

SENATOR CONWAY: The amendment is adopted. Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 2 to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CONWAY: You've heard the motion. All in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed. It is advanced. Speaker Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Mr. Chairman and colleagues, I am going to move that we recess now until about eleven o'clock. We are working on some things with LB 1, so I would move now that we recess until eleven o'clock this morning.
