SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, I just echo Senator Hall's comments. I would hope that the body would not reconsider.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Does anyone else wish to speak to the motion to reconsider? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Ashford? Closing is waived. We'll now vote on the motion to reconsider. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to reconsider? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 16 nays, Madam President, on the motion to reconsider.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion is not adopted. Further motion, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Hillman would move to reconsider the vote on...with respect to the second part of the Hall amendment, FA4S4.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Hillman.

SENATOR HILLMAN: Madam Speaker, I would like to reconsider the second part. I don't have the really good reason for bringing this up as far as what I was doing as I was walking around the Chamber at the time and would like to have it reconsidered. I would like to see what the explanation is again, if Senator Hall would help me out with this. I have a feeling you could have some strong impact in some area that I was completely unaware of and out of courtesy would ask you if we could please reconsider this.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hillman. Senator Hall, followed by Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Madam President and members. Senator Hillman is right, it will affect Great Western Sugar. The...and that's the reason I divided the question on the amendment. They were drafted together and I knew that there were some people that were, in the Rotunda, were concerned about the change from sales factor only as it related to multistate corporations to property only.
