SENATOR WARNER: Yes, Madam President, I would rise to support Senator Moore's motion, assuming that the date gets placed in and I think it will for January 1. But I, too, have a concern that when we discussed this issue before that if an item is not going to pay sales tax, then it should be no question of whether it gets filed with the assessor for depreciable tax that would be taxed on depreciation to ensure that that will be recorded with the assessor. And, as I recall the discussion when we had this come up in the previous special session, the amendment that Senator Moore is now offering ensured that those...that the county assessor would be notified of equipment that was purchased on which no sales tax was paid. So I would support Moore's amendment and also the amendment to make it effective January 1 of '93 when that's offered.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Senator Schmit. Senator Schmit. Senator Lamb.

SENATOR LAMB: On the Baack amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay. Senator Hall, did you want to address this amendment?

SENATOR HALL: I support Senator Moore's amendment to the amendment. And in Senator Baack's amendment, Senator Warner raised the issue of the effective date of the act. It was my understanding that folks wanted it to be effective immediately so I changed it. It was...it did read January 1 of 1983 so I sent George up to bill drafters, said, no, change that. So we're going up there and trying to find the original version, see if we can't bring it back down because that's drafted properly and here I was trying to help people out and I should have just sat in my chair again. But, anyway, that's coming back down, but that's the intent. By adopting Senator Moore's amendment, there will be a slight amendment on the effective date that will put the proposal in the version that folks had agreed to. And I would urge you to adopt Senator Moore's amendment at this time.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Hall. Does anyone else wish to address the Moore amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Moore?

SENATOR MOORE: Well, Madam President, I would simply ask for the adoption of the amendment like it has been passed out now
